Your ... **ASSIGNMENT**

Gather research for an essay about a hoax from the past. Eventually you'll explain the background of the hoax and people's reactions to it, but for now your task is to conduct research.

First you'll come up with a research question that will give you some direction as you search for sources about the topic. You'll find at least five sources and evaluate each for its credibility and relevance. You'll then choose the three strongest.

Your assignment should include the following elements:

- A research question to guide your search for sources
- A list of five sources that can potentially help you answer the research question
- A final list of three sources that are credible and relevant to the topic
- At least one source that is a different type of medium than the others

You should have completed a draft of this assignment in the activity before this one. If you haven't done so, go back and complete that activity now.

Tips for **SUCCESS**

Ask yourself these questions as you revise:

- Is my research question specific enough to keep me on topic as I conduct research? Will it lead to an interesting answer that isn't obvious? Will the question require an entire essay to answer?
- Are my sources relevant to the topic? Do they provide enough information to be helpful?
- Are my sources written by authors who have some authority on the subject? Are the publishers credible as well?
- Are my sources reasonably up-to-date?
- Are my sources presented in a professional way? Are they well written and free of obvious errors?
- If my sources are biased in some way, do they at least represent different perspectives?
