### **Final Creative Writing Story and Presentation Directives**

Your Creative Writing Stories should be 2 FULL pages in length, double spaced, 12 pt. Times New Roman font. Include a single spaced header with your name, course number, name of professor, and the assignment. Title your story. Page numbers are optional and if used should be inserted into your paper via the page numbering feature.

Your story must include the following: a contemporary theme (subject, topic) or motif (image, pattern) that donates to the idea(s) of your author of choice. Include a minimum two female characters. Include a setting (location, scenery) and a plot (scenario, narrative).

**Follow the rules of writing! Grammar, punctuation, and spelling will be strictly examined.**

**Choose a method to Recording Personal Observations/Research about 20th Century Women's Issues/Themes for your Final Class Presentation**

Choose a contemporary female author that has impacted you. What is noteworthy about her? What is her recording style? Choose your own recording style to represent her work for your final presentation. Look at the author through an artistic lens. What characteristics best define this author as an artist? Support your assertion(s) with examples from the course text, the additional course readings and outside sources. Be specific and back up **any and all** of your arguments with MLA citation. **Citation can be included in your project or it can be in a separate page.**
