Take a moment to scroll through the articles to find one that piques your personal interest. Once you have finished reading the article, address the following:

- Provide the **title** of the article you selected.
- Provide responses to the following **reflective questions**:
 - What is your **takeaway** from the article?
 - Why did this article **resonate** with you personally?
 - How can you **apply** what you have learned from the article to your professional and personal life in terms of the five practices?

Journals are private between the student and the instructor. Each journal activity will be graded individually.
