- Be specific and choose one body of work, a multiple set of works, or focus on one photograph that will help you better articulate what the photographer's personal vision might be in the work.
- Provide a bibliography.

- Title of the project or photograph?
- Photographer's personal vision?
- How does the work affect you?
- Who is the audience of this work?
- What is the purpose of this work?
- Is it successful? Who decides?
