ASSIGNMENT 2: CELERITAS LEADERSHIP PROJECT

Part 1: Due Week 7 and Part 2: Due Week 10 (40% of final grade)

Leadership comes with many challenges. You need to motivate, inspire and encourage your teams to work toward common goals. This assignment offers you an opportunity to apply what you have been learning about leadership to a complex business situation. It is designed to help you synthesize the leadership practices we have studied so far into informed recommendations that address the challenges presented in the case.

For this two part assignment, you will evaluate how leaders can ensure collaboration and cohesiveness among all team members. You will also demonstrate *your* ability to lead (e.g. appraise, evaluate, interpret, etc.), through this case analysis. Be sure to consider suggestions from your reading of Lencioni's, *The Five Dysfunctions of a Team*. Additionally, this case analysis should incorporate concepts and examples from the course lectures, discussions, videos, readings, and DiSC and TKI results.

NOTE: Assignment 2 is broken down into two parts. You will submit Part 1 (Problem and Analysis) of this assignment in Week 7 and Part 2 (Executive Summary, Revisions to the Problem and Analysis, and Recommendations) in Week 10.

Part 1: Problem and Analysis

Due Week 7, Sunday (15% of final grade)

During Weeks 4-6, we have explored a number of leadership topics from the perspectives of both team members and team leaders. This assignment will help to integrate these topics with the materials from Weeks 1-3 of the course. Be sure to make use of all that we have learned since Week 1, e.g., personal leadership style, the DiSC, TKI, etc.

Instructions

1. Read the Celeritas case.
2. Write a 3-6 page paper to address the following:
 - a. **Problem:** Define the issue or problem. Then, explain the background of the case study and identify how the Celeritas senior team was dysfunctional. (Suggested length: 1 page)
 - b. **Analysis:** Examine the possible causes of the issue or problem. (Suggested length: 2-5 pages)
 - i. How did CEO, Dr. Philip Boyer's leadership style contribute to the team's dysfunction?
 - ii. How is Boyer's leadership style different from Carla Reese's leadership style?



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- iii. Why was Dave Lloyd ineffective in influencing his boss and colleagues?
- iv. How could Lloyd have handled the off-site SVP meeting differently? What actions could Lloyd have taken to effectively work with his colleagues and get his career back on track?
- v. How effective were previous team building efforts at Celeritas? What worked well, and why? What didn't work well, and why?
- vi. What could this team of senior leaders have done to better understand the perspectives of each other and their boss?

Professional Formatting Requirements:

- Typed, single or double spaced, professional font (size 10-12), includes headings and subheadings, with one-inch margins on all sides. See the Sample Professional Paper under Course Documents for an example.
- References must be included and provide appropriate information that enables the reader to locate the original source. Application and analysis of course materials and resources is expected, and additional research is welcome.
- Include a cover page containing the title of the assignment, the student name(s), the professor's name, the course title, and the date.
- The suggested length is 3-6 pages, excluding your cover page and reference list.

Part 2: Executive Summary, Revisions, and Recommendations

Due Week 10, Sunday (Weight: 25%)

During Weeks 7-10, we have explored a number of leadership topics from the perspective of leading in organizations. The assignment will help you integrate this with what you have working on throughout the course. To help with this, make use of all you have learned since Week 1 including your personal leadership style, the DiSC, TKI, etc. You will need to formulate your recommendations with a consideration of the time and resource constraints described in the case that have the potential to undermine the trust the team leader is seeking to build.

For this assignment you will continue your Celeritas case study analysis by providing an Executive Summary, revisions to the problem and analysis, and offer your recommendations for improving teamwork and resolving conflicts more effectively. You will also have the opportunity to improve Part 1 (Problem and Analysis) based on the feedback that you received from your instructor.

NOTE: Since this component of the assignment is a continuation of the work you completed for Part 1, you should continue your work in the same document that you submitted for Part 1 (Problem and Analysis). Even though the Executive Summary comes first in the paper, it is often written last since it presents a synopsis (or overview) of the entire paper.

Instructions

1. Read the Celeritas case again.
2. Write a paper that addresses all of the following:
 - a. **Executive Summary:** Briefly summarize key points of the paper. (Suggested length: 1 paragraph)
 - What is the problem or issue?
 - What are the possible causes of the issue or problem?
 - What solutions do you recommend?
 - b. **Problem and Analysis from Part 1 of this assignment:** Implement any feedback that you received from your instructor. (Suggested length: 2-5 pages)
 - c. **Recommendations:** Acting as a leadership consultant to Boyer (and applying principles and practices from this course), what recommendations would you make to improve teamwork and resolve conflicts more effectively? (Suggested length: 3-4 pages)
 - How would you facilitate buy-in by all team members? For example, are there any short-term goals, and mission or vision statements, that could galvanize the commitment of all employees, especially the senior leadership team?
 - What would you do to build and to maintain trust among all employees to ensure Celeritas' mission and vision are achieved?



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- What must change about the existing organization culture, as it relates to collaboration and cohesiveness, for Celeritas to thrive in their market segment?
- What should be done to ensure a return to profitability within 6 months?

Professional Formatting Requirements

Your submitted assignment must:

- Be typed, single or double spaced, professional font (size 10-12), includes headings and subheadings, with one-inch margins on all sides. See the Sample Professional Paper under Course Documents for an example.
- References must be included and provide appropriate information that enables the reader to locate the original source. Application and analysis of course materials and resources is expected, and additional research is welcome.
- Include a cover page containing the title of the assignment, the student name(s), the professor's name, the course title, and the date.
- Be 6-10 pages in length, excluding your cover page and reference list.
