2. It often takes a misunderstanding to destroy a relationship. Discuss how Richard destroys his relationship with his wife.
3. What does the philosophy book that Richard finds symbolize?
4. When we have successes and failures in life, we often try to understand them by attributing blame or responsibility. How does Richard understand the failures in his life?
5. Identify and describe the ironic element(s) in the story "The Paperback Book."
