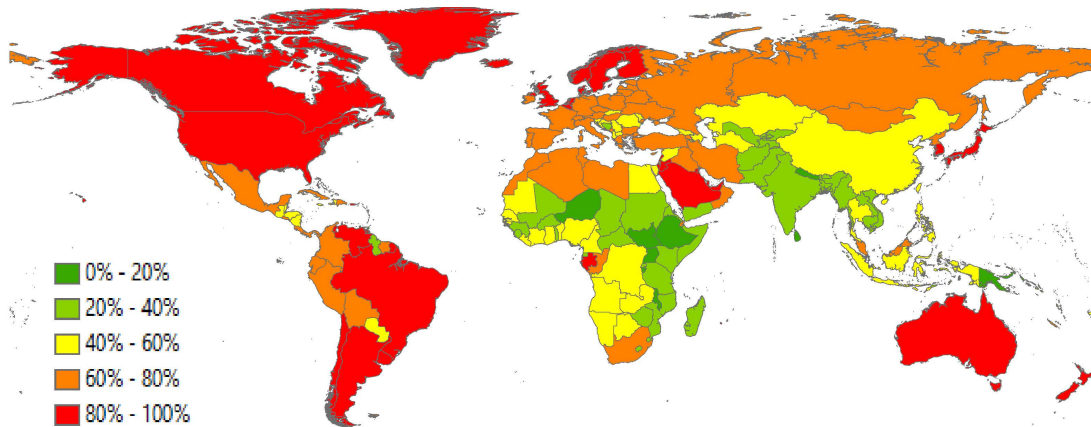


Urbanization

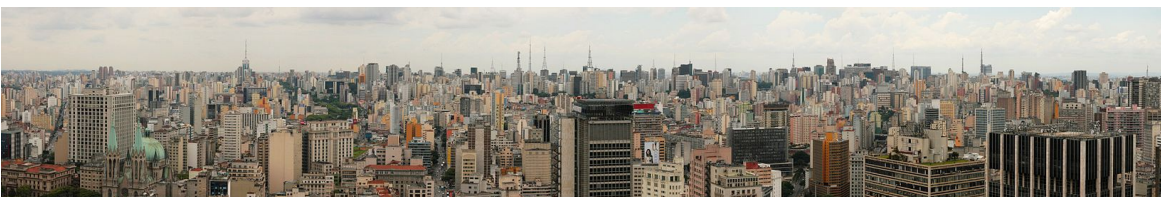
This week is a good test of how far you've come in learning about geography, whether you understand how the subject applies to your life, and whether you can think like a geographer.
