

## PSYC101 Week 6 Tip Sheet: Completing the Week 6 Worksheet and Reviewing Grading Feedback



The Week 6 Worksheet guides you through the key elements of a published scholarly journal article and demonstrating APA source citation skills, activities you will engage in frequently as you complete assignments including essays, research papers and literature reviews in future courses.

  - The worksheet requires unpacking the key elements of the published scholarly journal article attached to this screen and demonstrating APA source citation skills, activities you will engage in frequently in the completion of a variety of assignments including essays, research papers and literature reviews in future courses.
  - Quoting is not permitted. All answers must be written as paraphrases, meaning that you must restate what you read in your own words, with the exception of technical terms such as the names of diagnostic tests. You are not required to source credit the article. In your answers to the Section I. "Key Article Components" questions, Section II. "Source citing and reference listing in APA format" is where you will demonstrate knowledge of how to correctly format source crediting in APA style.
  - Answers will be graded for accuracy, thoroughness, clarity and correct spelling and grammar.

### When completing your worksheet keep in mind:



This assignment is a worksheet, not a paper. You will be answering a series of questions focusing on particular components of an assigned, published journal article.



The worksheet and the article required for completing it are attached as links to the bottom of the classroom assignment screen. Open each by clicking its link.



Nothing may be deleted from or altered in the original worksheet Word document.



Although you may not submit it before Week 6 of the course term, working ahead and pacing completion of the worksheet is recommended, just as you would do with a paper based on a scholarly journal article or articles.



You should only source cite in answering the questions at the end of the worksheet requiring demonstration of APA source citation skills. There should be no other source citations in your work.



No quoting or copying is permitted. Only technical terms and proper nouns from the article may be used as-is in your worksheet answers. Everything else must be paraphrased (restated in your own words).
