

Choose a psychologist from the first century of the history of psychology (1879–1979). Compile information about the historical figure from credible sources. You should search for biographies, case studies, and contributions to the field of psychology of the psychologist whom you choose. Next, format the collected information into a research paper.

Your research paper must include the following information about the historical figure:

- Describe the life and work of the historical figure in the field of psychology.
- What were the historical figure's major contributions to the field of psychology?
- Which psychological perspective or school of thought do the historical figure's ideas most closely adhere to?
- Is this perspective or school of thought still in existence in psychology today? Why, or why not?
- Cite all sources used in the APA format, including at least three in-text citations from each source and a References page.

Submission Requirements:

Submit your work in a Microsoft Word document of the following specifications:

- Font: Arial, Size: 12 point
- Line Spacing: Double
- Length: 500 words
- Citation Style: APA. Refer to the sample APA title page given in the handout titled "[APA Title Page Format](#)."

Evaluation Criteria:

Your submission will be evaluated against the following criteria using the [research rubric](#):

- Did you describe the life, work, and major contributions of the historical figure, as well as the person's school of thought or perspective?
- Did you explain why the school of thought or perspective of the figure is or is not in existence today?
- Did you find a minimum of three credible sources?
- Do you incorporate helpful information from each of the sources?
- Did you cite the sources correctly, using APA format?

- Does your assignment meet the minimum word requirement (500 words)?
