1. Start a MS Word document for your screen captures. Name your file **Lab8.doc(x)**.
2. Start **Wireshark**.
3. Click Capture, Options and select your interface.
4. Click Start.
5. Open a browser and go to **nmsu.edu**.
6. Click Stop and review the packets captured.
7. Do a screen capture of the capture packets and copy it into your **Lab8.doc** document.
8. **Answer in your document:** Interpret the packets displayed in your screen capture. Identify the task of each of the packets captured.
9. Exit the browser.
10. Click Capture, Options and locate the Capture Filter for selected interfaces box.
11. Enter ip src **YOUR IP ADDRESS GOES HERE. the box with be green when the format is correct.**
12. Click Start.
13. Open a browser and go to **nmsu.edu**.
14. Click Stop and review the packets captured.
15. Do a screen capture of the capture packets and copy it into your Lab8.doc document.
16. **Answer in your document:** Interpret the packets displayed in your screen capture. Identify the task of each of the packets captured.
17. Exit the browser.
18. Click Capture, Capture Filter box.
19. Select everything except for **HTTP TCP port(80) tcp port http**
20. Use the minus at the bottom left of the Capture Filters window to delete the selected filters.
21. Click OK.
22. Click Capture Start.
23. Open a browser and go to **nmsu.edu**.
24. Click Stop and review the packets captured.
25. Do a screen capture of the capture packets and copy it into your Lab8.doc document.
26. **Answer in your document:** Interpret the packets displayed in your screen capture. Identify the task of the sets of packets captured.
27. Upload **Lab8.doc** into this dropbox.
