

## **CMST 2064 Small Group Annotated Bibliography**

An annotated bibliography includes a list of sources but also a brief summary and evaluation of each source. Annotations may also include thoughts on the credibility and relevance of a source.

To complete this assignment each group must complete and annotated bibliography with a minimum of **10 academic sources**.

You must see the Owl@ Purdue on our course Moodle page and pay close attention to the section labeled: *Annotated Bibliography Example* After the completion of the annotated bibliography you may realize some sources are not appropriate for the Informative speech. This is a possibility. Please make sure each entry details what section of the INFO speech it will be used for. For example, “Carter’s treatise on animal husbandry will be useful in creating the Attention Gathering device of the speech introduction. My audience will be rather surprised by his findings and be more inclined to pay attention to the remainder of the speech.”

You must create your document utilizing MLA format and create MLA formatted entries.
